THIS DAY IN NATURALS HISTORY

On September 6, 2009, the Northwest Arkansas Naturals punched their ticket to the postseason with a 2nd Half North Division title, in a 6-3 win over the Tulsa Drillers at Drillers Stadium. The Naturals scored four runs in the third inning, on back-to-back home runs from Vance Wilson and Cody Clark, then a two-run single from Jeff Bianchi. Clark homered again in the fourth inning, a two-run shot that at the time put the Naturals up 6-1. Starting pitcher Federico Castaneda allowed one run over 4.0 innings with four strikeouts, then John Bannister earned the win with three innings of two-run relief. Three pitchers after Bannister combined for 2.0 scoreless innings, with Aaron Hartsock throwing a scoreless ninth to secure his eighth save and a playoff spot.

Friday's Loss... Rudy Martin drove in two runs, but the Northwest Arkansas Naturals fell 4-3 to the Springfield Cardinals on Friday night. Martin's RBI double in the fifth tied the game after Springfield struck first with a solo homer. The two teams traded runs in the sixth, with **Spencer Nivens** hitting a sacrifice fly to even things at 2-2. Springfield pulled ahead with two runs in the top of the ninth. Martin's sacrifice bunt brought home **Dustin Dickerson** after he led off the bottom of the ninth with a triple, but the rally ended there as Springfield secured its 10th straight win. This is only the fifth series the Naturals have lost this season, and NWA looks to snap their four-game skid tonight with two home games remaining in the 2025 regular season.

Williams Back, Back Again... Right-handed pitcher **Henry Williams** makes his return from the injured list this evening. His last start came on August 23 at home against the Tulsa Drillers (LAD) where he punched out a career-high eight opposing hitters in 5.0 innings of work. The start was his 17th of the season, and secured Williams his fifth Double-A win of the season. Williams has only allowed more than four earned runs once in 2025, a start in May against the Drillers where he allowed 11 earned runs, but outside of the lone blip on the radar, 17 of his 18 other appearances have featured three or fewer earned runs.

Hitters Turning Heads... Entering Saturday's slate of games, the Northwest Arkansas Naturals are tied for the third-best batting average in all of Double-A at .257. The team's .341 on base percentage ranks fourth of the 30 AA squads, and their 33 triples rank first in the Texas League. The Naturals' offense has surged since the start of August; after hitting .238 in July, the Naturals finished August with a .282 batting average, and have started September hitting .287 through four games.

Peaks & Valleys... Currently on a four-game losing streak, NWA has had a season prone to high highs and low lows. The team has had 20 different streaks of three or more straight wins or losses in 2025, including 10 separate winning streaks that eclipsed at least three games. The team's longest winning streak came between August 10 and August 15 where they won five-straight, while the longest losing streak was six consecutive games from June 28 to July 3.

Developing & Producing... The Northwest Arkansas Naturals have had a number of players find success in their facilities this season. Of the current top-10 prospects in the Kansas City Royals organization, the only two above the High-A level spent the majority of their season in NWA prior to a promotion. The team's number seven prospect, RHP **Ben Kudrna** is currently with the Triple-A Omaha Storm Chasers after he finished his time at the Double-A level on a tear that saw his season's ERA with the Naturals drop to 4.21. Meanwhile, Kansas City's number two overall prospect, **Carter Jensen**, just made his major league debut. The catcher played over half of his games (68) with NWA this season, where he erupted for 19 extra base hits, seven stolen bases and a career-best .292 batting average. This is without even mentioning **Jac Caglianone**, who no longer has prospect status but produced dominant numbers in AA with the Naturals. The tall lefty led the Texas League in both home runs and RBI for over a month following his departure, and has returned to the Royals' active roster after his rehab assignment with the Storm Chasers.

Nats vs Mautz... Springfield's starting pitcher for the penultimate game of the series is a familiar face for the Naturals. **Brycen Mautz** is set for his fourth start against the club in 2025, a matchup where the left-hander has found plenty of success. Mautz has pitched 13.2 innings against the Naturals this season where he's allowed five total runs (no more than two in an individual outing) and recorded 13 strikeouts. However, a few Naturals have had their way with Mautz in their individual duels. **Gavin Cross** is two-for-four against Mautz with a double and an RBI, while **Dustin Dickerson** is three-for-seven (.429) with a home run and .857 OPS against the starter. In **Brett Squires'** lone start against Mautz, the first baseman finished one-for-two (.500).

Crossing Special Territory... **Gavin Cross** extended his hitting streak to 15 games last night, matching the longest streak of the season for NWA. He has 22 hits in that span with seven doubles, two triples, six home runs and 13 RBI. The Royals' number 23 prospect is hitting .319 on the streak with a 1.099 OPS and has added six stolen bases.

The Royals Family... The Kansas City Royals have a 5:15 PM CT first pitch at home against the Minnesota Twins with RHP **Stephen Kolek** on the mound. The AAA Storm Chasers continue their road series against the Iowa Cubs (CHC) at 6:08 PM CT with RHP **John Gant** in line for the start. In High-A, the Quad Cities River Bandits have a 5:30 PM CT start against the Cedar Rapids Royals (MIN). LHP **Mason Miller** is set for his 10th A+ start of the season, and looks to continue a stellar showing that has his ERA at 1.00. The Low-A Columbia Fireflies are on the road against the Myrtle Beach Pelicans (CHC). LHP **Darwin Rodriguez** is the Fireflies' scheduled starter in the penultimate game of the series that is set to get underway at 5:05 PM CT.

Henry Williams takes the mound with the Nats for his 18th start of the season after a short stint on the IL. The right-hander's last start came on August 23 at home against the Tulsa Drillers (LAD) where he punched out a career-high eight opposing hitters in 5.0 innings of work. He earned the win in the contest the Naturals secured 9-7.

Before The Royals... Prior to being dealt to the Kansas City Royals organization, the right-handed pitcher was selected with the 91st overall pick in the 3rd round of the 2022 MLB Draft. He started 12 games with the Lake Elsinore Storm, the Class-A affiliate of the San Diego Padres. In his time with the Storm, Williams finished with a 1-5 record and an ERA that read 5.74. He struck out 40 batters and issued 21 base on balls in 42.1 innings of work.

Lighting it Up with the Fireflies... After being traded, Williams quickly became a mainstay in the Columbia Fireflies rotation. The 6'5" arm made his debut with the Class-A affiliate of the Royals on August 8, 2023, where he pitched 5.0 shutout innings, fanning four batters and being credited with the win. The starter finished his 2023 season with five total appearances (all of which were starts) with Columbia, where he had a 3.38 ERA in 24 total innings of work.

Quad Cities Dominance... Williams spent the entirety of the 2024 season with the Quad Cities River Bandits. The then 22-year-old accumulated 22 appearances, 21 of which were starts, where he tallied 102.2 innings of work. Williams finished his A+ season (his first full campaign in the Kansas City organization) with a 3.68 ERA, holding opposing players to a .231 batting average, and garnering a 1.22 WHIP.

Shall I Compare Thee to a Summer Day... Williams month of August in 2024 was... Spectacular; and that almost feels like an understatement. The right-handed pitcher went 3-0 across five starts where he fully found his footing. He finished the month holding a 1.16 ERA in his five starts, while opponents hit .156 for the month. Williams' WHIP in August over his 23.1 innings pitched was a staggering 0.73.

Duking it Out... Williams spent his collegiate career playing for the Duke Blue Devils. The hefty arm pitched in nine games in his two seasons with the Blue & White, (one in the COVID-shortened 2020 season and eight in the 2021 season) starting seven of such outings. Williams finished his college days with a career ERA of 3.82 and a batting average against of .255. Williams was Duke University's Saturday starter in 2021 before tightness sidelined him in mid-April. Even in saying such, he finished the season ranked third on the team in WHIP (1.27) and helped the Blue Devils break their program record in strikeouts per nine innings (9.81).

Two-Sport Stud... Williams did far more than pitch at Darien High School. He lettered in both baseball and basketball in all four years at the high school, and was even a team-captain of the basketball team as a senior small forward and shooting guard. In the classroom, Williams excelled, earning his membership with the National Latin Honor Society.

Connecticut Made... Williams finished his senior season ranked as the third-best right-handed pitcher in his class in the state of Connecticut, and the 12th-overall player in the state by Perfect Game USA.

A Day to Remember... On September 4, 2024, Williams pitched three perfect innings. He recorded three strikeouts and didn't allow a single player to reach base en route to a River Bandits 5-1 victory over the Sky Carp.
